
Dear Mr. Horton:

The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality – Hazardous Waste Division (ADEQ) has completed their review of Corrective Action Strategy (CAS) Work Plan Addendum. The revised CAS Work Plan dated June 25, 2004 and the Addendum dated September 1, 2006 are approved.

Per discussion in the June 2006 meeting and the contents of the aforementioned addendum, Whirlpool is required to remediate the “on-site” contamination (i.e. source area) as well as the off-site groundwater plume. In addition, any future submittals of laboratory data must include acceptance criteria for off-site blanks, field duplicates, matrix spikes and spike duplicates, and all laboratory Quality Assurance.
